Power Wheel Demo Derby Entry and Release Form Event Rules:

Pre-registration/ Registration: \$20.00 Cash Only (Paid at Power Wheels Pit tent day of event). Parent must provide cars and helmet for the kids that are participating in the Power Wheels derby. Parents must pay gate entry fee to get onto the grounds for the Power Wheels derby. Parents may purchase Derby ticket at Power Wheels Pit tent.

Heats: There will be 2 classes: Ages 4-6 that will run before the Demo Derby starts and ages 7-9 will run during intermission of the Demo Derby. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will receive an award per class. 1 hardship award will be given per class, decided upon by judges. In the case of a tie breaker, sudden death will take place. Sudden death will consist of 1 balloon per car, placed above any tire the child chooses. Children get 2 minutes to pop the balloon. The awards will take place directly following the classes in the arena.

Check in: Children and cars can be checked in from 3:30- 5:30pm at the tent in the back of the arena (Power Wheels pit tent). All cars must stay in the Power Wheels pit area the entire night unless they are in the arena or going home.

Safety: All children must wear approved safety helmets; bicycle helmets are acceptable. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges, use zip ties or duct tape or other flexible product for making them stay shut.

Power Wheel Build: Any regular electric Power Wheel is allowed. No 4-Wheeler type vehicles allowed. Child's legs must be in a compartment. Ride In NOT on!! The Power Wheel vehicle can have UP TO a 12-volt lawn mower battery, which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat and battery must be secured and sealed away from the child either in the front or back of the vehicle. Wheels may be modified using a single strip of bicycle tire on each wheel.

Power Wheel Decorations: Decorative changes can be made to the Power Wheel to look like a demo derby car but can NOT be reinforced in any way. Changes and additions are only decorative. For example: Cardboard or Pool Noodle header pipes sticking up, painting the car, etc. NO roll cages, added plastic, metal, etc. At all times remember that this is for the kids!! Don't add something that could cause them not to be in the Power Wheels Derby. You could have a disappointed child if they are not allowed to participate.

Power Wheel Event: Each car will be given 3 balloons, 1 on Right, Left and Back side of car/Truck (Inflated balloons will be provided and attached by WCF member). Each Class will be given 7 minutes. The last child with a balloon or the child with the most balloons at the end of the 7 minutes will be the winner. One parent must be in the designated area provided on the track during the time their child is in the arena. ONLY 1 PARENT ALLOWED in the Arena and Pit Area.

Awards: 1st Place Award: Belt Buckle, 2nd Place award: Leather Banner, 3rd Place award: Leather Ribbon and Special Hardship Award
